I recently completed a four mile "race". I put "race" in quotation marks because I am far from competitive. For me, it is not a "race" but an act of self-discipline.

I participate in this event nearly every year and I tell people that last 5,280 feet are a real challenge! The only

way that I can get to the end is to constantly tell myself not to quit and simply take one more step.

I believe that that is what a life of discipleship is like: taking one more step, going one more day. The disciples asked the Risen Lord if He was about to restore Israel's kingdom. They didn't yet understand that the restoration of Israel's kingdom was not on God's agenda. Rather, God was going to do a new thing; you know, a new wine and new wineskins sort of thing. Jesus answered their question saying that we don't need to know what God is doing next. But, and this was a very big "but," strength will be given as it is needed. In John's gospel, Jesus said that followers of Jesus would be given a "helper," the Holy Spirit.

What was for the disciples to know, though, and for us to know, is that we are called to tell others of God's saving love, and how our lives are different because we take Jesus seriously. We are to be constant witnesses in word and deed until we cross the finish line from this Reality into the Next.


