"Go fly a kite!"

It's not a bad idea. It may even good theology.

As a boy I loved to make the oldfashioned diamond-shaped kites with long tails made out of discarded rags tied together. I

remember my dad helping me launch my kite toward heaven, and seeing it float gently upward, becoming smaller and smaller as the string gently tugged against my fingers. As I lay in the quiet dark of my room at night I could still feel the wind in my hair and the gently pull of the string.


"The wind blows where it wills, and you hear the sound of it, but you do not know whence it comes or whither it goes; so it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit. (John 3:8) Flying a kite may be a good spiritual exercise because it can remind us of the gently tugging and prodding of the Almighty in our lives.

It has been said that the plans we have for others are

doomed to failure. This is also true of the plans we have for God. To paraphrase Thomas Aquinas: we propose and God disposes. Sometimes we feel sidetracked in life as our plans fall apart. Sometimes we feel that God is remote from the day-to-day decisions of our lives. But nothing could be farther from the truth. God speaks to us in the events and circumstances of life as well in the still small voice of the soul. Somehow--often in ways that we cannot understand--God is at work in our lives, tugging at us with the same gentleness that a wind tugs at a kite. All the while, sometimes against our desires, we are brought closer and closer to the promises of the Kingdom.

Sometime as the March winds blow in the warmth of Spring, I hope that my grandchildren ask me to fly a kite with them. I'll do it. And as that kite soars higher and higher in the sky, I will marvel at the hand of God in my life.

So, "Go fly a kite!"



Have you ever thought something worked one way, only to find it didn't? Like maybe as a kid you thought the bathtub drain was a death trap. Then you learned it couldn't actually suck you into the sewer and that was a game changer.

Or maybe you were sure that the closet should be avoided because monsters lived there. Then you learned they didn't. That changed your morning routine for sure.

Any time you learn new information, it can turn your world upside down.

Jesus had a habit of doing just that with the people closest to Him. He often did or said things that were the exact opposite of what anyone expected. He'd take ideas that everyone agreed with, ideas that everyone would say, "Of course, that's just the way it is," and He'd flip them upside down. He would tell people to do the exact opposite of what they thought.

This was especially true when Jesus talked about how we treat people, specifically people who like us, people who don't, and people we don't even notice.
