## 100th Anniversary of the End of World War 1



*(Piper James Richardson of the 16th Battalion, depicted in the painting above, won the Victoria Cross for his bravery in playing the bagpipes above the trenches in the Battle of the Somme, while exposed to intense enemy fire for an estimated 20 minutes. Piper Richardson is the only Canadian piper to have won the Victoria Cross, the highest of all British and Canadian military decorations. 
