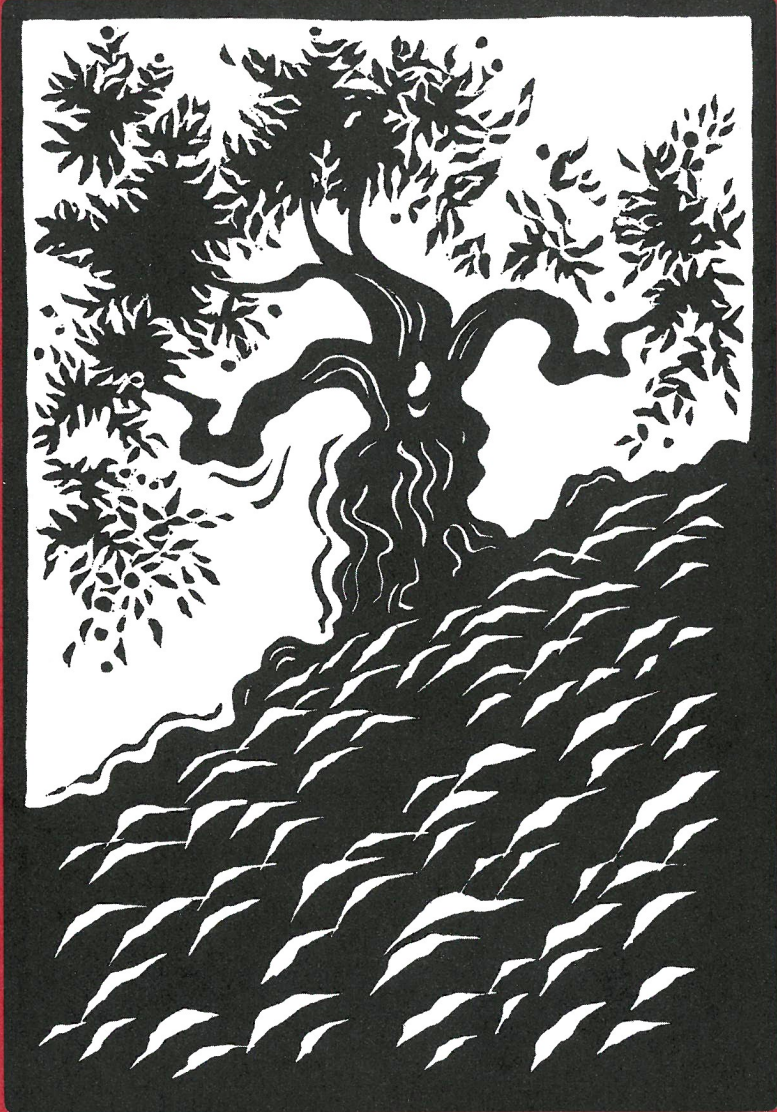

(Luke 11: 9-11)

Responsive

Leader: Jesus said: "Ask and it shall be given you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you."

Congregation: For every one who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened.

Leader: Friends in Christ, God knows our needs before we ask, and in our asking prepares us to receive the gift of grace. Let us open our lives to God's healing presence, seeking peace with God and reconciliation with our neighbors. Let us be mindful not only of personal evil but also our communal sins of family, class, race, and nation. Let us confess to God whatever has wounded us or brought injury to others, that we may receive mercy and become for each other ministers of God's grace.

Amen.*
