
- Large print hymnals, individual listening devices and reading glasses are available in the Narthex for an improved worship experience.

Sunday School is provided each week during 10 am worship.


- Preschoolers 5th grade go to the chapel briefly for announcements and offering before being led to separate Sunday school rooms.

(Moment of silent prayer)


Congregation: Hear our prayer for those who put the welfare of others ahead of their own and give us hearts as generous as theirs. (Moment of silent prayer)
