
- Large print hymnals, individual listening devices and reading glasses are available in the Narthex for an improved worship experience.

Sunday School is provided each week during 10 am worship.


- Preschoolers 5th grade go to the chapel briefly for announcements and offering before being led to separate Sunday school rooms.

church; the communion of saints; the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and the life everlasting. Amen.


